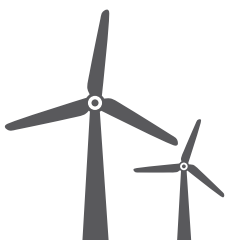

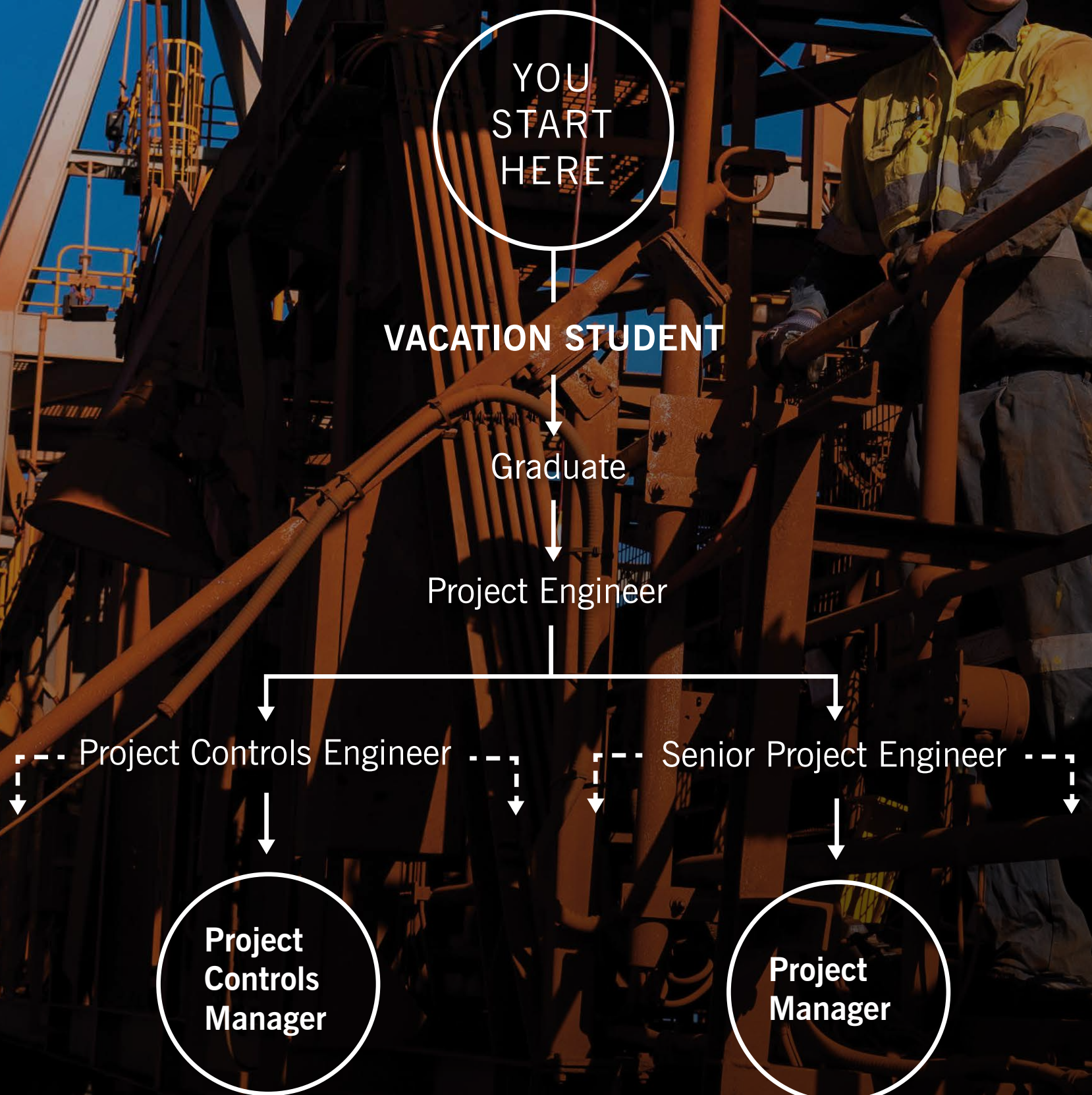


CAREER PATHWAYS

MELISSA'S STORY

A day in the life of an Engineering Graduate



5:00am – WAKE UP

Time to start the day! I get up, get ready and am out the door by 5:15am to travel to site, which is approximately 15 minutes away from camp.

5:30am – SUPERVISOR'S MEETING

We begin each day with an informal meeting with all the engineers and supervisors to discuss a plan for the day ahead, any issues and milestones to accomplish.

6:00am – PRE-START

The daily pre-start meeting kicks off at 6am. The crew are briefed on their allocated tasks, and identify major hazards

and the subsequent controls that will be in place. Customer advisors and supervisors attend and provide support on any general site notices. Then, the crew can bring up any issues, work or housekeeping prior to starting work. We finish off every pre-start with stretches.

6:30am – BREAKFAST

I have breakfast after pre-start as I am not usually hungry at 5am in the morning. For breakfast, I usually either have cereal or yoghurt and muesli. On fly out days, I'll wake up earlier and treat myself to a full cooked breakfast.

7:00am – DAILY REPORT

First up on my list of tasks for the day is sending out the daily report. This is submitted to the customer to inform them of progress, any issues, working conditions, health and safety, personnel and plant on site.

8:00am – PROCUREMENT

There are always items that need to be purchased on site, such as concrete reinforcement or small items like tools. I'll look at drawings to calculate quantities and refer to standard documents for the material specification. Then I'll request quotes from suppliers and raise purchase orders. I often need to follow up to ensure we get the materials delivered to site in time.



10:00am – PLANNING FOR UPCOMING WORKS

I also assist with planning and preparing for the upcoming works. Some work items require developing methodologies and schedules, and others require contractor drawings and documents to be submitted for customer approval. There are a variety of different tasks performed on the job, which is nice as it helps build a diverse knowledge and skillset.



12:30pm – LUNCH

Time for some more food. I'll usually just sit down and eat lunch at my desk and have a chat to a few of my colleagues.

1:00pm – SUBCONTRACTOR MANAGEMENT

Subcontractors are mobilised to site to perform specialised tasks. I'm involved in organising their mobilisation documents, planning their dates, and submitting any documents for customer approval.

3:00pm – SITE DRIVE

I will go for a drive around the various work fronts most days. This helps me keep on top of the progress and gives me a chance to take photos for the daily report or future works. During this time, quality checks can also be conducted to inspect that the work is constructed as per the design drawings and specifications.

For example, several checks that need to be conducted for the installation of valves include confirming the valve opens in the correct direction and verifying the bolts are tightened to the correct torque value. I will then ensure that all relevant documentation is signed off by the customer in preparation for the project close-out.

4:00pm – SAFETY INTERACTION

Whilst I am out in the field, I often complete a safety interaction. I normally have a chat with one of the work crews, checking their pre-starts, work area set up, isolations and work with the team to understand if anything could be done in a safer manner.

5:00pm – FOLLOW UP EMAILS

I normally take this time to follow up on any emails received throughout the day.

5:45pm – HOME TIME

Done for the day. We leave site and head back to camp around 5:45pm. Most nights I will either go the gym or do some form of exercise. Occasionally, you will see me at the pub for a drink and playing pool with some of the crew.

The camp has a wide range of activities – a swimming pool, basketball court and theatre room to name a few – so there is always lots to do.

7:00pm – DINNER

There's a wide variety of food on offer for dinner – salads, veggies, roasts, pasta, curries and lots more. I have dinner with my colleagues before packing my breakfast and lunch for the next day and heading back to my room.

7:30pm – WIND DOWN

The last hour of the day is “me time” where I will wind down by watching some TV, listening to music, or chatting to friends and family back home.

8:30pm – GOODNIGHT

Lights out. Time to reset for another busy day ahead.

WHAT NOW?

STEP 1

Online application

STEP 2

Invitation to a video interview

Even though it might feel uncomfortable, don't worry, we watch hundreds of application videos every year. We just want to know why Monadelphous is the right fit for you, your values and way of working, along with your understanding of the industry and how you can put your skills and experience into practice.

STEP 3

Assessment centre or face to face interview

You'll take part in a number of group activities along with a one-on-one interview to make sure we get a good chance to get to know you, and you get to know us. You will receive further information that will allow you to prepare through your assessment centre invitation.

STEP 4

Receive our offer

You'll hear back from us as soon as possible after the Assessment Centre with those successful receiving an offer to join the Program. Our commencement dates for the Graduate Program are in August and February. Our Vacation program starts in November.
